Circumstances:

The South Gate Police Department is currently investigating allegations of a possible fraud scheme involving the Super Sluggers Tournament to accept monies for an upcoming baseball tournament that did not take place and no refunds were provided. People interested in participating in the Super Sluggers Tournament were encouraged to mail checks to a Robert Rodriguez of South Gate, CA 90280. Paying participants were then informed that the tournament had been cancelled and that refunds would be mailed out immediate. Apparently no refunds were ever made and some media reports indicate that no arrangements had ever been made to secure the proposed playing fields.
