

## California Integrated Waste Management Board Grant

In 2010 the City of South Gate was awarded a \$95,619 grant from the CalRecycle. The City utilized this grant to install 527,000 square feet of rubberized asphalt concrete on Atlantic Avenue from Abbott Road to Firestone Boulevard, Kauffman Avenue and Dorothy Avenue from Firestone Boulevard to Southern Avenue. This project diverted a total of 14,938 California waste tires.
