

Otis Street Improvement Project, North to South City Limit: The project repaved 1.8 miles of roadway with rubberized asphalt, repaired deficient curb, gutter, sidewalks, retrofitted handicap ramps, and made other peripheral improvements. Ongoing work includes conversion of streetlights from series to multiple.

Cost: \$2.4 million, Funded with Proposition C

Status: Completion in Oct. 2007

Firestone Boulevard Bridge Widening over Rio Hondo Channel Project: This project will add a traffic lane in each direction, retrofit the bridge in compliance with the latest seismic standards and raised landscape median on Firestone Boulevard. The project is currently under construction.

Cost: \$16 million, Funded with Federal, State, Metro and Proposition C

Status: Completion in June 2008

Firestone Boulevard/Atlantic Avenue Intersection Widening Project: This project will make capacity and safety improvements. It entails widening Firestone Boulevard and Atlantic Avenue, widening and realigning the intersection, adding lanes, installing raised landscape medians, right-of-way acquisition, and other peripheral improvements.

Cost: \$18 to 20 million, Funded with Grants, Proposition. C, and other funds

Status: Completion in July 2008

California Avenue Street Improvement Project, North to South City Limit: This project will grind pavement, construct rubberized asphalt overlay, repair deficient curb, gutter, and sidewalks, retrofitted handicap ramps, convert street lighting s from series to multiple and other peripheral improvements.

Cost: \$3 million, Funded with Proposition C, Federal STPL,

Status: Completion in Oct. 2008

Atlantic Avenue Street Improvement Project, North to South City Limit: This project will resurface approximately 1.4 miles of pavement with rubberized asphalt, install raised landscaped medians, repair damaged curb, gutter, and sidewalks, retrofit handicap ramp, and make other peripheral improvements.

Cost: \$4.4 million, Funded with Federal Grants and Proposition C

Status: Completion in Dec. 2008

Garden View Avenue Street Improvement Project, Firestone Boulevard to Southern Avenue: This project will grind pavement, construct rubberized asphalt overlay, repair deficient curb, gutter, and sidewalks, retrofitted handicap ramps and other peripheral improvements.

Cost: \$500,000, Funded with Gas Tax

Status: Completion in June 2008

Safe Route to School Cycle I and II: This project replaced 3,000 square feet of deteriorated sidewalks; installed new handicapped ramps; new school warning signs; "thermo" plastic crosswalks around 11 elementary schools and a new traffic signal at the intersection of Tweedy Boulevard and Pinehurst Avenue.

Cost: \$910,000, Funded with State Grant and Gas tax

Status: Completed in July 2007

Firestone Boulevard Bridge Widening over Los Angeles River Project: This project will widen Firestone Boulevard on the southside, add a traffic lane in eastbound direction, modify southbound on ramp to I-710 and retrofit the bridge for compliance with the latest seismic standards.

Cost: \$12 million, Funded with Federal, State, Metro and Proposition C Funds

Status: Completion in June 2010

Firestone Boulevard/Garfield Avenue Intersection Improvement Project: This project will widen the intersection, install concrete approaches and other peripheral improvements.

Cost: \$1.4 million, Funded with Federal, Proposition C and Gas Tax

Status: Completion in June 2008
